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EDITORIAL

The Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality Management organized the International scientific conference entitled *Tourism in Southern and Eastern Europe (ToSEE)* for the third time in May 2015. Following the first call, 73 extended abstracts were submitted, of which 65 were accepted by the editorial board. Upon receiving the full papers, the peer-review process yielded 42 papers that were then accepted for conference presentation. The conference was attended by 50 participants from Croatia, Slovenia, Montenegro, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia, Romania, Poland, Spain, Italy, Australia and the UK.

The conference took place from May 14-16, 2015 in Opatija with the aim of bringing together experts from academia and international institutions to explore the theme of the conference *Sustainable Tourism, Economic Development and Quality of Life*. Sustainable development is a key concept and a global development priority for the whole society. The impact of tourism on economic development of tourist destinations is undeniable. However, one cannot ignore its negative impact on the broad environment in which tourism activities take place. This raises the issue of the relationship between tourism and economic development, and its environmental impact on the quality of life of tourists and host communities as well. In a situation where economic development is a must, scientists and professionals from different fields of research try to find the best possible solution for the future, while keeping in mind environmental protection, socio-cultural aspects and economic aspects at the same time.

Before you are the proceedings of the third ToSEE conference, which include 38 papers that have been modified according to the reviewers' requests and which have been accepted for publishing. The papers promote an interdisciplinary debate about strategies, methods, tools and good practices in the tourism of Southern and Eastern Europe.

Last but not least, we would like to take the opportunity to extend our warmest thanks to our authors and reviewers for their contributions to these proceedings.
